PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

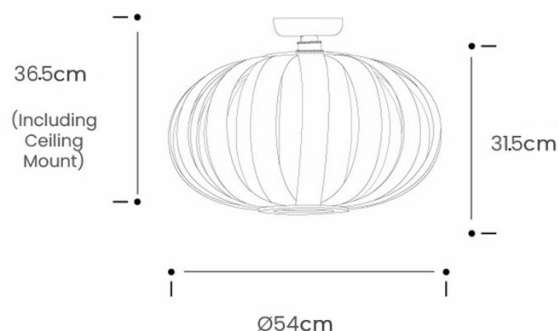

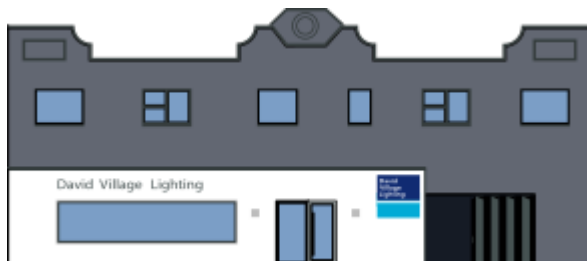
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The Urchin Ceiling Light is created using 32 pieces of timber, curved to its limits to create the concise arches that form the shade. Each piece of wood is naturally air-dried before being heated until they are flexible enough to be bent into the required shape. This process, known as steam-bending, is synonymous with Tom Raffield's brand. Steam-bending allows wood to be bent and twisted beyond its perceived limits to create sculptural pieces that are free from any glue. The curved petals of timber enclose the light source within, casting patterned rays of light that surround the shade.

The Urchin Ceiling Light is available in three finishes: ash, oak, and walnut. Ash and oak have warm tones, perfect for displaying in light and airy spaces. Both ash and oak will naturally darken over time. Walnut is the darkest of the finishes, and when illuminated, the golden wood contrasts effectively against the dark exterior. The Urchin Ceiling Light sits flush to the ceiling, making it a space-saving lighting solution for compact interiors. Install in communal areas such as a living room to add a welcoming and cosy ambiance to the room.
