Gubi 1967 Pendant

A classic 1950s design reinterpreted for the present day, the Gubi 1967 Pendant is a timeless piece by Finnish designer Paavo Tynell. Known for his softly modernist forms and refined use of brass, Tynell created lighting that was both poetic and functional. The 1967 Pendant showcases this philosophy with a conical canvas shade and signature brass detailing. A fabric diffuser beneath the bulb softens the illumination, producing a gentle ambient glow, while a decorative brass finial subtly enhances the interplay of light and material.

Ideal for dining areas, living rooms, or high-end hospitality spaces, the Gubi 1967 Pendant is as much a sculptural object as it is a functional light. The natural canvas shade emits a diffuse upward glow and focused downward beam, making it suitable as a central light source or part of a layered lighting scheme. Its understated profile and use of natural materials ensure it fits seamlessly into both traditional and contemporary interiors.

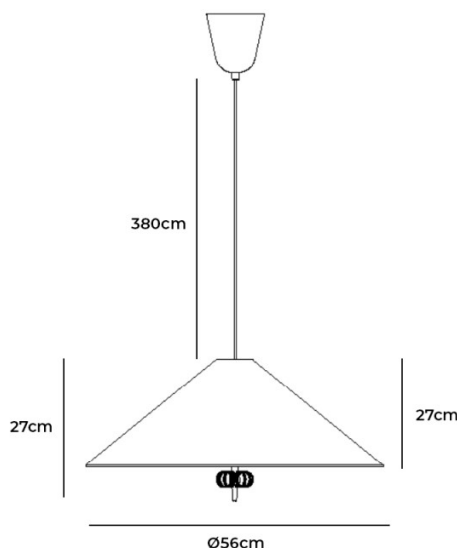
