PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

HAY Nelson Saucer Crisscross Bubble Pendant

Designed by pioneering American designer George Nelson in 1947 and first produced in 1952, the Bubble Lamp signalled a revolution in Modernist lighting. Inspired by a set of silk-covered Swedish pendant lamps that Nelson admired but found too expensive, the collection was born from his characteristic resourcefulness. Using a self-webbing plastic spray originally developed by the U.S. military, Nelson applied the material over a lightweight steel frame to create a durable yet delicate shade with a beautifully soft appearance.

Part of the iconic [Nelson Bubble Collection](#), the Nelson Saucer Crisscross Bubble Pendant combines a broad, organic silhouette with a distinctive crisscross pattern that adds subtle definition and visual interest. When illuminated, the translucent shade gently diffuses the light, producing a warm, even glow that helps create a calm and welcoming ambience. Its soft light output makes it ideal for living rooms, dining areas, bedrooms, and relaxed commercial settings, where it can provide atmospheric illumination while remaining an elegant sculptural feature even when switched off.

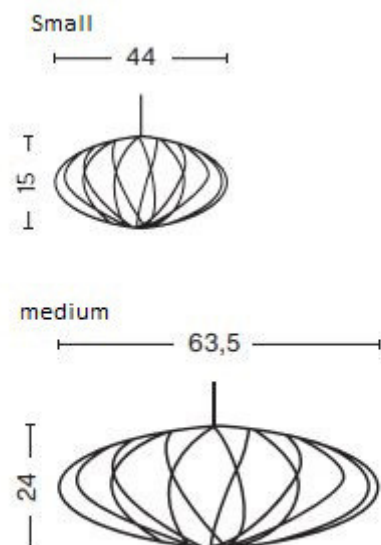
